#### **Group Equipment supplied:**

#### Brina:

Swimwear, towel, a picnic and a bottle of water.

#### Warning:

Participants must know how to swim and be in good physical condition. It is necessary to walk on a variety of terrains. Inform your guide of any health problems.

#### Acces

From Aubenas, follow the RN102 towards Le Puy to Lalevade d'Ardèche. At the roundabout on entering the village, turn left towards Jaujac. Here, follow signs to La Souche and Col de la Croix de Bauzon (RD19). At the col, continue on the RD19 for 3 km. At the crossroads, turn left towards Loubaresse (RD24). After 1.2 km, turn right towards Les Chambons. Drive through Le Chambon and continue through the woods on the small tarmacked road. After 1.5 km, you will see a sign "L'Escalade en Ardèche". This is our meeting point. From Aubenas: 1 hour 10 min / 51 km.
