Duration of the activity 2h30 Difficulty : Sportive

Walk there : 10'

Walk back : 10'

Personnal equipment supplied : Harness, safety straps, helmet.

Group Equipment supplied : Medical kit, ropes.

Bring :

Sturdy trainers or walking shoes, knee-length shorts or trousers suitable for walking, T-shirt, sunglasses, backpack with water and a snack.

Warning :

You must be in good physical condition. Inform your guide if you have any health problems.

Acces

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From Vals Les Bains, follow signs towards Le Cheylard / Antraïgues, 1.5 km after Vals, turn left towards Labastide sur Besorgues (RD 243). Drive up this valley, through the village of Labastide and continue as far as the hamlet of Freyssenet (RD 243). 800 metres after this, turn right towards Lachamp Raphaël (RD 354), then drive 3 km (just after the hamlet of Ponsac), cross a river bridge. The meeting point is approx. 3 km higher up at the third hairpin bend (before a wind turbine).



At the head of the Besorgues valley, come and discover via cordata – a mixture of climbing and via ferrata - in an isolated, rarely visited location. On the splendid promontory of the Rocher de l'Aigle, from where we have a 360° panorama of the Ardèche mountains, as well as of the Cévennes and the department of the Gard ! An unforgettable experience. Activity suitable for everyone aged 12 years or more (min. 45 kg. 1.40 m).

What to do nearby?

Just 15 minutes away by car, the Base Canyon possesses a shaded picnic area, a welcoming relaxation space and a play area for children. In July and August you will find a snack and salad bar and ice creams. Carry on up into the mountains to discover the Ardèche plateau and the source of the Loire at Mont Gerbier de Jonc. Numerous walks and bathing places nearby.
